DMC&H - Scholarship/ Awards Policy 2025-26

(Details of the various scholarships)

INTRODUCTION

This scholarship policy aims to promote academic excellence;

support deserving students and attract the best available

talent. This policy encourages and recognises the legacy of

service, asserts the primacy of merit, and has been inspired by

the benevolence ofpast, present and future stakeholders.

OBJECTIVE

To offer financial assistance to students admitted to DMC&Hfor

the 2025-26 session, based on merit, means and employee

commitment.

TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIPS

A. For students seeking admission in MBBS course for

the year 2025-26:

1.Merit:

Number of Scholarships: 3+5=8 (Eight)

Objective:To attract a cohort of high-quality talent students

who secured top rankings in NEET (Punjab merit list), and who

are granted admission to DMC&H.The presence of such a

cohort would benefit the current students of DMC&H as well.

Eligibility:Studentsranked amongst the top 25 in the NEET examination(Punjab merit list) and have securedadmission to the MBBS degree course at DMC&Hunder Govt. Quota

Number of Scholarships: up to 3 (Three)

 Among the top tenrank holders: ThreeFull scholarships(all feesplushostel charges, whereverapplicable)will be awardedin order of merit among first three rank holders till 10th rank who join DMC&H.

• Number of Scholarships: up to 5 (Five)

If more than 3 students among top 10 rank holders in NEET Punjab merit list join DMC&H, the fourth student and onwardswill be considered for 50% scholarship along with those ranked 11th to 25th.

These 5 scholarshipstill rank 25in descending order of merit will be for 50% of the full fee amount including hostel charges (wherever applicable):

2. Means Based Scholarship

To support students who cannot otherwise afford to provide quality medical education to their children in private institutions, and who have secured admission to DMC&H under Govt. Quota.

Number of Scholarships: 2+5+5=12 (twelve)

Eligibility: Wards with parental income of Rs. 8 lacs and below per annum and EWS Certificate holder.

- **Two** 100% scholarships including hostel fee wherever applicable.
- **Five** 50% scholarships including hostel fee wherever applicable.
- **Five** 25% scholarshipsincluding hostel fee wherever applicable.

All applicants should have been ranked at NEET (Punjab Merit) top 400 positions. In case the number of applicants exceed the number of scholarships, then the applicants with higher NEET scores will be selected.

3.Employee Ward Scholarship: 1+4=5 (five)

Eligibility:Children (wards) of doctors or other employees whohold regular, full-time positions at DMC&H, andhave completed at least 10 years of service at the institute. There should be no adverse employment recordand disciplinary action or court proceedings (past or pending) against the employee or initiated by the employee.

The scholarship would be valid only while the parent is actively employed at DMC&H.If the parent voluntarily resignsorhis services terminated, the scholarship support would cease from

that point. However, if the student leaves his/her coursemidstream, he/she would have to pay the balance feesalongwith 50% penalty of the scholarship amount, since his/her seat would continue to be vacant.

The employee-ward scholarship scheme is being designed to reward long-term commitment to DMC&H and to encourage employees to continue their association with the institute.

Number of Scholarships: upto 1(One)

• 100% of fee (without hostel)This scholarship is reserved for DMC&H staff with parental income of Rs 10 lacs and below per annum.

Number of Scholarships: up to 4 (four)

• 75% of fee (without hostel). In case the number of applicants exceed the number of scholarships available, those with higher NEET scores would be selectedfrom the merit list prepared in descending order of merit.

4. Defence -Forces 2(two)

The Scholarship Committee will award scholarships covering up to 50 % of fees(including hostel fees,if applicable)towards of serving Indian defence Forces (Army/Navy/Air Force only).

In case the number of applicants exceed the number of scholarships, then the applicants with higher NEET scores will be selected.

5. Awards for Students doing MBBS in DMC&H

1. Sports Award: 1 (One)

One sports award of Rs 3 Lac would be given to the Best All Rounder at the Annual Athletic Meet every year.

Annual merit award for existing students: 2+2+2+2 = 8(Eight)

Each academic year, two awards of Rs 1 lac each would be given to the two best performers (first two college positions in First Prof, Second Prof and Final Prof Part-1 and Part-2).

B. Awards for Students doing BSc Nursing

This scholarship would allow deserving candidates to pursue education in DMC&H College of Nursing, which is one of the leading nursing institutes in North India.

Number of Scholarships: 10+20=30 (Thirty)

- Upto Ten 100% of fee (including hostel fee, if applicable)
- Upto Twenty50% of fee (including hostel fee, if applicable)

B.Sc. scholarship holders would have to serve the institution for a minimum period of three years after completing their graduation; a bond would be executed to this effect. The scholarship would have to be returned with an additional 50% penalty should the student in question choose to leave before this period. In case the number of applicants exceed

the number of scholarships on offer, the applicant with a higher rank in the entrance exam would be selected.

C. B.Sc. and Diploma (Paramedical courses):

With a view to create a pool of trained and qualified technicians to support doctors, this scholarship will help meritorious students whose parents are not able to afford education in private institution.

Number of Scholarships: 3+5 =8 (eight)

Eligibility: Wards with parental income of Rs. 8 lacs and below per annum andvalid EWS Certificate.

- Upto Three 100% of fee(including hostel fee for girls only if applicable)
- Upto Five 50% of fee (including hostel fee for girls only if applicable)

In case the number of applicants exceed the number of scholarships, then the applicants with higher merit will be selected.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process will be designed and codified by the DMC&H operating team and thereafter reviewed and approved by the Scholarship Committee.

LAST DATE TO APPLY:

- Within 15 days of the final admission listbeingpublished.
 (Scholarship type 1 to 4).
- For the students doing MBBS and securing merit positions it will be within 15 days of the MBBS professional examination results being declared by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences. (Scholarship type 6).

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- NEET Score Card (for MBBS)/PPMET score card (For Nursing) /+1&+2 result card(for paramedical Courses)
- Proof of admission to DMC&H
- Latest income certificate with ITR of last 3 years of both parents and valid EWS Certificate (as applicable)
- Affidavit containing information on concurrent scholarships or any other financial assistance.
- Certificate from Human Resources& Employees Relations
 Department of DMC&H (for employees' wards)

DISBURSAL MECHANISM

 The scholarship amountswould be credited directly to the applicant's appropriate bank account (first instalmentwhich has to be deposited directly with BFUHS will be paid directly by the student and will be reimbursed later after the student joins and the start of regular classes)

- In the case of partial scholarships, the balance fee should be paid by the student in advance before the last date of fee deposit.
- Scholarship amounts would be paid directly to the student fee account of DMC&H provided student fulfils the scholarship criteria continuously.
- For students selected for scholarships, bank guarantee/surety bond would be waived off.

MONITORING & REVIEW

 An annual review of the policy and awardees' performancewould be done, as per criteria.

Misrepresentation or false documentation

This would lead to cancellation and recovery of the scholarship and balance fee, sincethe institute would have lost an opportunity to serve eligible candidate; a penalty amounting to 50% of the paid amount would also be charged.

Cancellation

Should a student withdraw from the course, or is expelled, or if the information provided to avail the scholarship is found false, the scholarship would be cancelled with immediate effect. The full course fees would thereafter need to be paid to DMC&H along with a 50% penalty. (An affidavit would have to be submitted to this effect).

Prizes

Same student cannot be awarded more than once during his/her course in order to give opportunity to others.

• Employee ward Scholarship

- There should be no adverse employment record; there should be no disciplinary action or court proceedings (past or pending) against the employee or initiated by the employee. If any such issue emerges before, during, or after the scholarship period, DMC&H is entitled to recover the scholarship amount in full or in instalments over a period to recover the full amount alongwith penalty of 50% of the scholarship amount.
- The scholarship would be valid only while the parent is actively employed at DMC&H. If the parent voluntarily resigns, the scholarship support would cease from that point. If the services are terminated by DMC&H, the latter would recover the scholarship amount already paid. However, if he/she retires after two years of grant of scholarship, the scholarship would continue.
- In all cases where a student withdraws from the College, he/she will have to pay balance fees of the course, besides the above mentioned.

CRITERION FOR CONTINUATION OF SCHOLARSHIP IN MBBS COURSE

- Must have more than 85% attendance in theory (Including ECE, AETCOM, Pandemic modules etc.) and more than 90% attendance in practical/clinical posting in each phase individually in each subject.
- Must pass all term, ward leaving and send up examination including theory and practical in first attempt with minimum 50% marks
- Must have more than 80% attendance and more than 80% score in each elective.
- Must have more than 75 % in internal assessment in each subject (theory and practical/clinical individually) in each phase.
- Must not have been detained in any subject
- Must pass all professional university examinations in first attempt with more than 65% marks
- Must not have had any disciplinary action against him/her during the course
- voluntary Conditions:
 - To participate in at least one cultural/ sports event during the course.
 - Commit to sponsor at least 5 needy and deserving students in his/her lifetime.
 - To plant minimum 20 trees every year, nurture them and on passing out hand over to incoming students.

Scholarship for BSc Nursing

The scholarship would have to be returned with an additional 50% penalty should the student in question choose to leave before this period. In all cases where a student withdraws from the College, he/she will have to pay balance fees of the course, besides the above mentioned.

Criterion for continuation of scholarship in BSc Nursing course

- Must have more than 90% attendance in theory and 100
 practical/clinical/community postings individually in each subject.
- Must pass all term and sendup examinations in first attempt with more than 50% marks
- Must have more than 65 % in internal assessment in each subject (theory and practical/clinical individually)
- Must not have been detained in any subject
- Must pass all University semester examinations in first attempt with more than 60% marks
- Must not have had any disciplinary action against him/her during the course
- Voluntary Conditions:
 - To participate in at least one cultural/ sports event during the course.
 - Commit to sponsor at least 5 needy and deserving students in his/her lifetime.

To plant minimum 20 trees every year, nurture them and on passing out hand over to incoming students.

Criterion for continuation of scholarship in Paramedical courses

- Must have more than more than 85% attendance in theory, practical and clinicals or laboratory posting.
- Must pass all term and sendup examinations in first attempt with more than 50% marks
- Must have more than 65 % in internal assessment in each subject (theory and practical/clinical individually)
- Must not have been detained in any subject
- Must pass all University semester examinations in first attempt with more than 60% marks
- Must not have had any disciplinary action against him/her during the course
- Voluntary Conditions:
 - To participate in at least one cultural/ sports event during the course.
 - Commit to sponsor at least 5 needy and deserving students in his/her lifetime.
 - To plant 20 trees every year, nurture them and on passing out hand over to incoming students.

Policy Review

This policy would be reviewed every year.

CONDITIONS

- The policy would apply only to candidates who are admitted to DMC&H by BFUHS as per Govt. norms.
- All Scholarship schemes would be based on Govt. Quota fees.
- This scholarship policy does not apply to students in the NRI category.
- Scholarship applicants should not be receivingany other grant/scholarship/financial support from any other source during the tenure of their scholarship. An affidavit to this effect would have to be submittedat the time of admission, and again at the time of graduation. (This will be part of documents required to be submitted).
- Scholarships would be renewable/paid annually, based onspecific criteria. Scholarships not availed in a particular category would automatically lapse. Wards of DMC&H employees may apply in any of the three categories provided they fulfill the appropriate criterion.
- The scholarships are issued by DMC&H Managing Society at their sole discretion and can be withdrawn/amended any time.
- Awardees/their parents forego their right to any judicial recourse at any time. The awardees should furnish an affidavit and declaration to this effect (along with relevant documents as required under clause 5.)
