World Breast Feeding Week

To commemorate the World Breast Feeding Week falling on 1st to 8th August, 2012, Department of Pediatrics organized activities for the entire week. These included a series of lectures, declamation contest and a poster making competition to provide practical tips for successful breast feeding, and to highlight the advantages for both mother and baby.

MCI Workshop

Departmental Profile

The Department of Psychiatry started as a sub-speciality way back in 1970 with Dr RL Narang as head. It functioned out of a one room OPD in the old DMCH campus and there was no indoor section. Patients were admitted in the Medical ward. Six months later, a common house surgeon was appointed for Psychiatry and Dermatology. In 1972, the indoor facility was formally started by allotting 3 beds in the Medical ward for Psychiatric patients. The number of beds was increased to 10 in 1976 when a separate Psychiatry ward was introduced. The bed strength increased to 20 in 1978 and subsequently to 30 in 1984. Dr Narang served the institute till 2000.

Dr Ranjive Mahajan joined the department in 1991 and has further contributed to elevate the status of the department to a centre of Academic and Clinical Excellence. The other faculty members Dr Navkiran S Mahajan, who joined in 2002 and Dr Rupesh Chaudhry, in 2007, are both alumni of the department. The services of a Clinical Psychologist (Dr BP Mishra) and a Psychiatric Social Worker (Sukhmani Grewal) are also available full time.

Teaching Programme

The UG teaching programme is conducted in accordance with prescribed MCI guidelines. The department runs a robust PG teaching program. The MD course was initiated in 1985 with intake of one student which was increased to two in 1987. Since all infrastructure and faculty requirements were adequately met, MCI approved further increase in intake of PG students to 3 in 2011. The department continues to participate in

multiple international research projects. Our PG students have won awards at several PG development programmes.

Clinical Psychiatry Section

The department has evolved to its present day state-of-the-art indoor facility where comprehensive treatment with Psychopharmacological agents as well as an array of psychosocial treatment modalities are easily accessible. Modified ECT is being administered for the past 15 years. Well equipped and spacious OPD block ensures comfortable and comprehensive psychiatric work-up involving a team comprising Psychiatrist, Psychologist, and Psychiatric Social Worker.





Rural Health Training Centre, Pohir

Rural Health Training Centre, Pohir

Department of Community Medicine operates a Rural Health Training Centre at village Pohir, Block Dehlon, which was established on August 3, 1988 under the headship of Dr (Col.) Ved Parkash with just 2 villages viz. Village Pohir & Lehra under its care. Over the years, the centre has maintained the pace of progress along with the institution and has adopted 15 villages catering to a population of 31,869. The centre is celebrating its silver jubilee year in 2013. The department provides a comprehensive home based family health services to 6149 families through a efficient team of 24 supervisors/health workers/village health guides.

The centre has a unique system of maintaining complete health records of the entire population in the form of family folders offering a wealth of health data of the entire cohort since 1988. The dedicated team comprises of Incharge (Dr Mahesh Satija), MOH (Dr Vikram Kumar Gupta) and 4 Medical Officers under the headship of Dr Anurag Chaudhary. There are over 40 staff members including supervisors and other utility staff.



Pain Management Services

Pain is a major health issue throughout the world. Both acute and chronic pain is poorly managed for a wide variety of cultural, attitudinal, educational, and logistical reasons. Unrelieved pain has major negative effects on the lives of millions of people in our country and is associated with high costs involved in its treatment. Persistent pain and many physical and psychosocial changes and complications associated with it constitute a major health problem. Chronic Pain is now considered as a disease in its own rights.

In India, chronic pain affects approximately 30% of adult population, particularly women and elderly. In fact, 80% of the patients visiting any hospital or doctor have pain as their major complaint. About 20 – 25% of this population suffers pain from musculoskeletal and joint disorders. Back Pain accounts for another 25-30%. Headache and migraine accounts for about 5% of cases of persistent pain. In only 1-2% of adults with chronic pain does the pain result from cancer. Trigeminal neuralgia, postherpetic neuralgia and other neuropathic pain syndromes constitutes another 5-7% of patients suffering from Chronic Pain.

At Dayanand Medical College and Hospital the Department of Anesthesia has evolved a pain management program providing care to acute and chronic pain patients. PAIN CLINIC has been started in the OPD and consultation is available for acute as well as chronic pain. We offer:

Acute Pain Treatment Service

A consultative service to help manage pain in the hospital.

- A Patient-controlled analgesia (PCA) is administered to many of our patients for postoperative pain and also other acute pains.
- ▲ Epidural analgesia for labour pain and other acute pains.

Chronic Pain Management

Through a dedicated pain clinic, we treat the patients who have a variety of chronic pains including: Cancer pain, Headaches, Reflex sympathetic dystrophy, Fibromyalgias, chronic back pain, cervical spondylitis, joint pains, migraines, neuralgias, facial pains and causalgias.

We aim to assist patients to reduce the impact of persistent pain by expert assessment, patient education and by a number of treatment modalities including both pharmacological and interventional techniques provided in a coordinated manner so that all the dimensions of the patient's condition are treated. The centre undertakes research on outcomes of pain treatments, psychosocial aspects of chronic pain, pain and ageing and novel therapies for pain.

Some modalities employed at our centre are:

- ▲ Diagnostic & Therapeutic
- Pharmacological management.
- ▲ Trigger Pain Injections
- Intra-articular injections
- Nerve blocks
- Caudal approach for epidural lysis of adhesions
- Chronic Opioid Management in indicated cases
- Percutaneous disc Neucleoplasty
- Intraspinal Drug Delivery Systems
- ▲ Spinal Cord Stimulator Implantation

Our treatment goals include:

- ▲ Diagnose and treat chronic pain syndromes
- Reduce pain and increase comfort
- Increase the ability to manage pain and related problems
- Increase physical capabilities and activities
- Support the return to productive activity
- Minimize the use of medications
- Improve the quality of life
