
Subject: Renewal of permission for admission of 2<sup>nd</sup> Batch of MBBS students against the increased intake i.e. from 70-100 at Dayanand Medical College, Ludhiana for the academic year 2017-18.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to MCI's letter No. MCI-37(1)(RI-56)(UG)/2016-Med/164893 dated 28.01.2017 on the subject mentioned above and to convey the approval of the Central Government for renewal of permission for admission of 2<sup>nd</sup> Batch of MBBS students against the increased intake i.e. from 70-100 for the academic year 2017-18 at Dayanand Medical College, Ludhiana under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

2. The permission is valid for one year and for admitting only one batch of students against increased intake i.e. 70-100 during the academic session 2017-18. The next batch of students in MBBS course against increased intake will be admitted in the college only after permission of Central Government for renewal/recognition.
3. The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J&K, Andhra Pradesh & Telengana States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the renewal permission is granted for all India quota.
4. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under IMC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of MCI and the Central/State Government.
